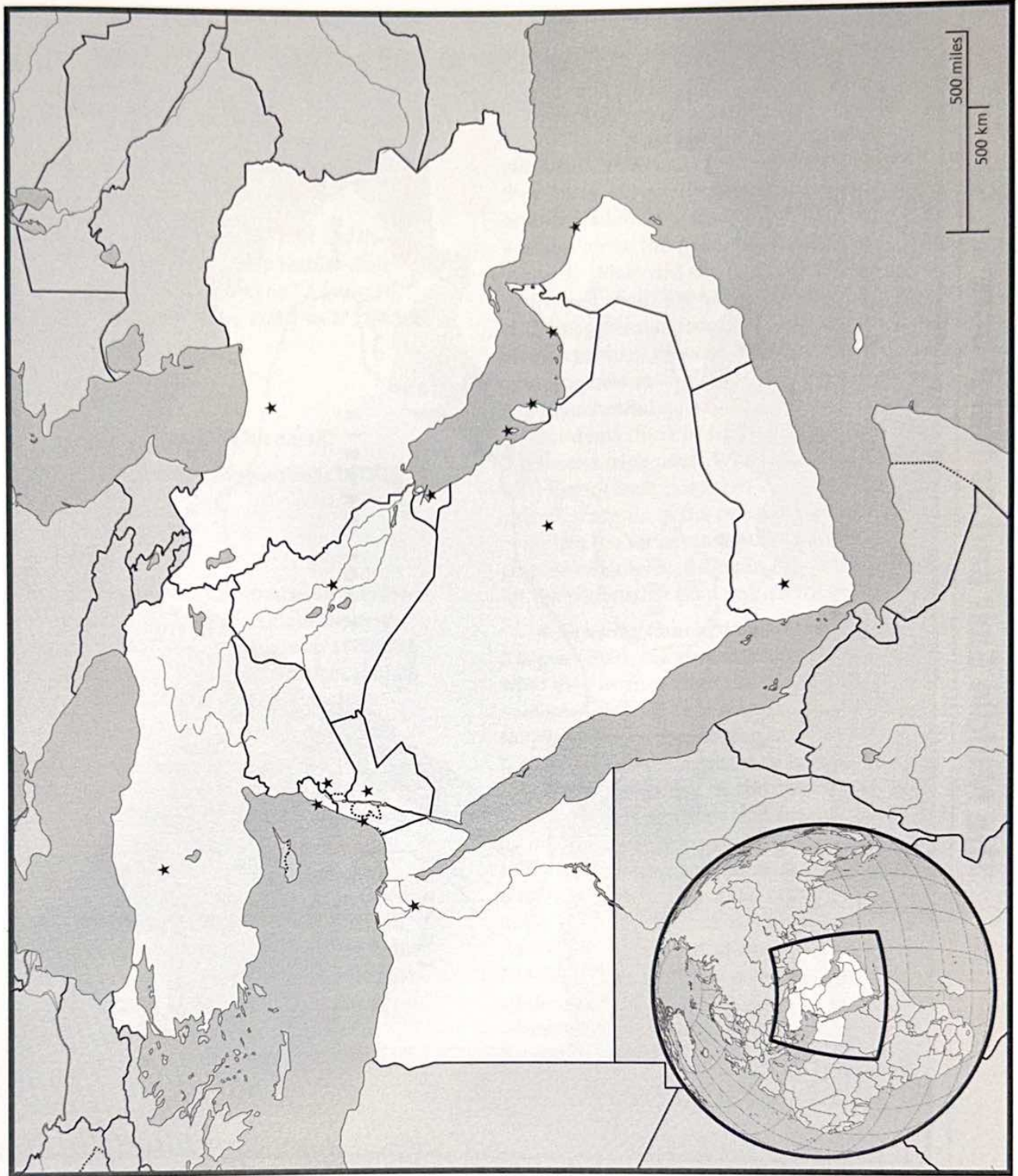
4. Fill in the missing countries and capitals in the chart below. Then place all countries and capitals on the map "The Middle East."
